Using Camera and Sound in Adobe Connect

1. Login and Settings

- Go to the URL of the meeting. Login with your name as a guest if you do not have an account.

Flash Player 10.3 is required to access the meeting. Download and install Flash Player if necessary: <u>http://www.adobe.com/products/flashplayer</u>.

If you cannot access the meeting perform Connect Test on this page: <u>https://webconf.vc.dfn.de/common/help/en/support/meeting_test.htm</u>. Send results.

- **Connect your headphones and webcam to your computer**. Use headphones and not speakers to listen to sound during the meeting.

- Go through the Audio Setup Wizard (Meeting -> Audio Setup Wizard) to test audio functions.

At the step "Select Microphone" choose the Microphone of the Sound Card. The name of the Sound Card depends on your Sound Card. You should not select the Microphone of the Camera.

2. Talking

To talk select "Connect my Audio" next to the Microphone button at the top.
